

# Articles of Faith

## The Holy Scriptures

We believe in the plenary (complete) verbal inspiration of the Bible and that "all Scripture is given by inspiration of God" and that it is inerrant (without error) in its original writings, being communicated by the Holy Spirit to men of God.

(2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21; Matthew 5:18; John 16:12-13)

## The Person and Work of Christ

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ, the eternal Son of God, became man without ceasing to be God, having been conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary in order that He might reveal God and redeem (to regain possession by purchase) sinful men. (John 1:1,2,14; Philippians 2:5-8; Luke 1:35)

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died on the cross for all mankind as a vicarious (substitutionary) sacrifice; we believe that the sufficiency of this atoning sacrifice to accomplish the redemption and justification of all who trust in Jesus is guaranteed by His literal, physical, resurrection from the dead. (Romans 3:24, 25; Ephesians 1:7; 1 Timothy 4:10; Hebrews 2:9; 1 Peter 1:3-5, 2:24)

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ ascended to heaven and is now exalted at the right hand of God, where, as our High Priest, He fulfills the ministry of Representative, Intercessor and Advocate. (Acts 1:9; Hebrews 9:24; 7:25; Romans 8:34, 1 John 2:1-2)

## Salvation

We believe that God sent Jesus Christ as the Savior of mankind. Through the offering of Himself on the cross and upon the sinner by faith believing and receiving Christ, Jesus has reconciled (brought back into harmony) the sinner and his Creator. Because we are spiritually dead it is God the Holy Spirit who initiates, draws, convicts, and convinces us to believe. (John 1:12; 3:14-16; 6:44; 16:8; Hebrews 9:14; Romans 3:24-25; Colossians 1:21-22; 2 Corinthians 5:19; Ephesians 2:1)

We believe that all who thus receive Him are born again and become members of the family of God, eternally secure because of the promise of the unchangeable Word of God. (John 1:11-12; 5:24; 10:28-29; 1 Peter 1:23; Ephesians 3:11; 4:30; 1 John 5:11-13)

We believe that Scripture clearly forbids the use of either the assurance of our salvation or Christian liberty as an occasion to sin. (Romans 13:13-14; Galatians 5:13)

## The Godhead

We believe in one Triune God, eternally existing in three persons (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) co-eternal in being, co-identical in nature, co-equal in power and glory, and having the same attributes and perfection. We believe that God is sovereign (supreme).

(Genesis 1:1, 26; 3:22; Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; John 4:29; 10:30; 2 Corinthians 13:14)

## The Total Depravity of Man

We believe that man was created in the image of God; that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature, are totally depraved, and that they must be born again to be accepted of God. (Genesis 1:26, 27; Romans 3:10, 3:23; 5:12; John 3:1-6)

We believe that, because of Adam's sin, every person born into the world inherits a fallen sin nature and is thereby totally depraved. (Romans 3:10-19, 23; 5:12)

## God the Holy Spirit

We believe, the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, fully God in all aspects. He inspired holy men of old to write the Scriptures. (Genesis 1:2, Isaiah 61:1-3, 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21)

We believe the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ and, in this age, to convict men, regenerate the believing sinner and indwell, guide, instruct, and empower the believer for godly living and service. Through illumination He enables mankind to understand truth. Through efficacious grace He calls mankind to the saving knowledge of Christ's redeeming love and effects regeneration. At the moment of regeneration, He baptizes every believer into the body of Christ, once and for all, and seals every believer unto the day of redemption. (Matthew 1:18; 3:16; 4:1; 12:28-32; 28:19; Mark 1:10,12; Luke 4:1,18-19; 11:13; John 6:37; 15:26; Romans 1:6-7; 1 Corinthians 2:10-14; 2 Corinthians 1:21-22; Ephesians 1:13-14; 4:30; Philippians 1:6; 1 Timothy 3:16; 2 Timothy 3:16; Titus 3:5; 2 Peter 1:21; 1 John; 5:6-7.)

We believe the continuous filling of the Holy Spirit cultivates Christian character, comforts believers, and sovereignly bestows spiritual gifts to every believer by which they serve God through His church. (Luke 12:12; John 14:16-17, 26; 16:7-14; Romans 5:5; 8:9-11, 14-16, 26-28; 1 Corinthians 12:3-11; 2 Timothy 1:14; 1 John 4:13)

### **The Blessed Hope**

We believe the next great event in God's program is the Blessed Hope, the pre-tribulation rapture, when the dead in Christ shall be resurrected and the living saints translated and caught up together to meet Him in the air. (Titus 2:13; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17)

### **The Eternal State**

We believe in the bodily resurrection of all men, the saved to eternal life with Christ and the unsaved to judgement and everlasting punishment. (Matthew 25:46; John 5:28-29; 11:25-26; Revelations 20:5-6, 12-13)

We believe that souls of the redeemed are, at death, absent from the body and present with the Lord, where in conscious bliss they await the first resurrection, when spirit, soul, and body are reunited to be glorified forever with the Lord. (Luke 23:43; Revelations 20:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:8; Philippians 1:23; 3:21; I Thessalonians 4:16-17)

We believe that the souls of the unbelievers remain, after death, in conscious misery until the second resurrection, when they shall appear at the Great White Throne Judgement and shall be cast into the Lake of Fire, not to be annihilated, but to suffer everlasting conscious punishment. (Luke 16:19-31; Matthew 25:41-46; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9; Jude 6,7; Mark 9:43-48; Revelations 20:11-15)

### **The Ordinances**

We believe in Scriptural baptism by immersion as an ordinance of this Church and that each member of the Body of Christ should be baptized. (Acts 8:38-39; 10:47; 16:33; Romans 6:3-4)

We believe that the Lord's Table was instituted by the Lord Jesus Christ, and that all believers should assemble themselves together to remember Him in His death until He comes again. (Matthew 26:26-28; I Corinthians 11:23-32)

### **The Reign of Christ**

We believe in the personal, pre-millennial and visible return of the Lord Jesus Christ to the earth, when He will sit upon the throne of His Glory and judge the nations, after which He will reign for one thousand years in righteousness and peace. (Matthew 24:29-30; 25:31-33; Acts 1:11; Revelations 19:11-16)

### **The Personality of Satan**

We believe that Satan is a personal being, a fallen angel and the author of sin; we believe that he is the open and declared enemy of God and man, and that he shall be eternally punished in the Lake of Fire. (Job 1:6-7; Isaiah 14:12-17; Matthew 4:2-11; 25:41; Revelations 20:10)

We believe that he is the "prince of the power of the air," and the "God of this age," who is now "blinding the minds of those who believe not, lest the light of the Gospel of Christ should shine unto them." (2 Corinthians 4:3-4; Ephesians 2:2)

### **The Church**

We believe that the Church, which is the body and the espoused bride of Christ, is a spiritual body made up of all born-again persons of this present age. (Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:25-27; I Corinthians 12:12-14; 2 Corinthians 11:2)

We believe that believers should not forsake that assembling of themselves together. (Hebrews 10:25)

We believe that the establishment and continuance of local churches is clearly taught and defined in the New Testament. (Acts 14:27; 20:17; I Timothy 3:1-13; Titus 1:5-11)
